She also volunteers as a member of Metro's Committee on Racial Equity and FEAST Grantee, an initiative of the Oregon Food Bank.

She is committed to advancing equity in planning and understands how to work with diverse groups. I'm pleased to appoint her to the Planning and Sustainability Commission and look forward to having her be a member of this advisory body.

### **Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

#### Purpose of Agenda Item:

To confirm the appointment of Daisy Quinonez to the Planning and Sustainability Commission to serve a term October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020.
